## MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

This **MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING (MoU)** made and entered into on the date 23rd March 2023 and SIGNED by the following parties:

A. **Gulab Bai Yadav Smriti Shiksha Mahavidhyalaya, Borawan, India**, expression of which shall mean and include its successors in interest and assigns of the first part (hereinafter referred to as **GBYSSM**), and Add: Gulab Bai Yadav Smriti Shiksha Mahavidhyalaya, Borawan, Madhya Pradesh, India, 451228

B. **Global Young Leaders, Saint-Jean Carénage, France**, expression of which shall mean and include its successors in interest and assigns of the second part (hereinafter referred to as **GYL**), Add: Global Young Leaders, Résidence Le Rocher Vert Lot. No. 4, Saint-Jean Carénage, France, 97133

### PREAMBLE

**Gulab Bai Yadav Smriti Shiksha Mahavidhyalaya (GBYSSM)** is promoted by the “GulabBai Yadav Smriti Shiksha, Mahavidyalaya Trust, Borawan” under the dynamic leadership of its principal trustee Late Shri Subhash Yadav Ex. Deputy Chief Minister, Govt of M.P..

**GBYSSM** is a College of Education. **GBYSSM**'s qualified and dedicated faculties are not only transmitting the quantum of knowledge but also creating dynamic personalities. They are constantly endeavoring to shape the budding talents and enhance their potential in various aspects of human personality so that they value the norms of society and contribute immensely to the life of the global community. **GBYSSM** uses rigorous and intensive integrated teaching methods to prepare future teachers. **GBYSSM** understands the future teachers are the architects of the society. **GBYSSM** is making efforts to provide congenial environment for their students to bloom.

**GBYSSM Mission:** To emerge as a centre with Academic and Research Integrity for Professional Excellence in Teacher Education and allied disciplines for preparing teachers from rural and marginalised community.

**GBYSSM** is approved by NCTE Delhi, Reconized by Govt. M.P. Affiliated to DAVV, Indore (M.P.) , NCTE Approval No.: WRC/5-6/39/2002/04841.

**Global Young Leaders (GYL)**, '*create life by your own design*' is an international organization with a Not-for-Profit objective, established in 2019 in France, Europe.

**GYL mission:** GYL equips young people with personalized life-skills & perspectives for both their professional and personal life. Life-skills assist them in creating life by their own design through developing the tools they need to tackle their important life challenges, changes and decisions. Our peer-to-peer programs target key life topics like decision-making, well-being, mindset, intuition, external influences, life-skill development, and real-world changes and challenges.

**GYL outreach:** based in the French West Indies, GYL has hubs in Europe, North America, South Asia and Africa that work with independent groups of young people, schools, universities, and organizations internationally.

**GYL vision:** to empower young people to realize their full potential and create life by their own design of success and happiness.

Both GYSSM and GYL have decided to enter into this MOU with a view of sharing a common interest to explore, extend and strengthen the functional relationship including Academics, Research Guidance, Extension and Training aimed at Educational, Academic, and Interpersonal Excellence as per their given respective mandate, aims and objectives in the following sections.

#### **ARTICLE 1: PURPOSE and MODALITIES**

In order to achieve the goal of inclusive education, it is necessary for GYSSM and GYL to act in a convergent manner within the purview of their respective statutory provisions by sharing the academic resources and expertise available with both the parties, herewith GYSSM and GYL sign this Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) to cooperate and jointly work in the following general agreements:

1. Maximum and Sustainable use and utilization of available academic/virtual resources with both the parties, to conduct joint programmes of research, extension and training in such a synchronized manner that each of the parties entering into agreement gets maximum advantage from their mandated objectives as well as for synergizing existing academic courses, research, extension and training programmes and schemes.
2. The faculty, officers, research staff of GYSSM and its departments and GYL of either party if needed, may take part in teaching, research, guidance, extension and training activities in an academic session, as worked out and as per specialization and for the benefit of students, and faculties by mutual consultation.
3. Faculty, officers, and Research staff of either/or both parties may apply for joint collaborative projects. Data generated and /or publications through such collaborative endeavour could be published in joint authorship / joint copyright.
4. Undertaking Research Studies, Collaborative training programme, Exchange programme as per respective mandate and objectives of both parties would be taken up by the faculty, officers, and Research staff/Community Members.
5. Both the parties would cooperate and encourage sharing of experience, scientific knowledge, and technology advances, and its dissemination or expansion in communities/societies.

6. All research materials/sensitive data used in the collaboration will be transferred using Material Transfer Agreements (MTAs). Either party may use such materials but will give due credit to the source of the materials.

7. GYSSM and GYL will work together in developing an academic program and/or training courses in history and heritage studies for communities within and beyond the organisation. The two parties may organize sessions, workshops, seminars, and mentoring sessions etc at regular intervals.

8. GYL and GYSSM will circulate the initiatives via official channels namely, notices, social media, press releases etc.

9. GYL shall appoint/depute a responsible person as coordinator to ensure the proper functioning of the unit set up to conduct the program covered under the MOU.

10. GYSSM and GYL may annually award certificates to encourage research, innovation, and dedication among community members.

## **ARTICLE 2: COORDINATION**

Each institution shall appoint one member of its teaching/research faculty/community member to coordinate the programme on its behalf. Further, a coordination committee consisting of a programme coordinator from the side of GYSSM, and a programme coordinator from the side of GYL, will periodically review and identify ways to strengthen cooperation between the two institutions.

## **ARTICLE 3: DURATION, TERMINATION AND RENEWAL**

1. This MOU will be initially effective for the period of Two (02) years from the date of entering into it.

2. Notwithstanding anything contained in the MoU, the confidentiality and sociality of any research data or otherwise shall not supersede the Acts, Rules and Laws of respective Institutions entering upon the MoU.

3. Either institution may terminate the MoU by giving written notice of three months in advance to the other institution. Once terminated, neither GYSSM nor GYL will be responsible for any losses, financial or otherwise, that the other institutions may suffer. However, GYSSM and GYL will ensure that the provisions of this Memorandum shall continue to apply to all activities in progress until their completion.

4. This MOU may be amended or modified by a written agreement signed by the representatives of both institutions.

## **ARTICLE 6: ADHERENCE TO LAWS**

Participating faculties, staff, students and community members involved in any activities under this memorandum must adhere to the law of the respective countries and the rules and regulations of the institutions.

## ARTICLE 7: LEGAL EFFECT

Nothing in this Memorandum shall be construed as creating any legal relationship between the institutes. This Memorandum is a statement of intent to foster genuine and mutually beneficial collaboration.


## ARTICLE 8: DISPUTE RESOLUTION
