

PEER FEEDBACK

Peer feedback is an important source of learning for students. The students of the institution are encouraged to give and receive feedback to their peers in different learning situations. The students are given group work in the classroom to help them gain a better understanding of the concepts learnt. The group work may sometime involve a presentation by the group. Each person of the group contributes to the presentation and one person in the group volunteers to give an oral presentation. The teachers ask the others in the group to provide feedback on the oral presentation. This is done by asking students to fill a format developed for this. The students record their feedback and give them to the presenter. The presenter is able to understand the areas to be improved.

Peer feedback is also given during the time of practice sessions prior to the practical examination. The students practice in groups the lesson they have planned to take on the day of practical examination. Every member of the group gets a chance to present her lesson before others. The others record their observations in a "Peer Teaching Competency Feedback Form" developed by the institution. The feedback thus obtained helps to improve the teaching competency of the students.
